## **Sports Premium Budget 2023-2024**

This academic year the school received £17,740 to invest in the provision and promotion of sport, activity and healthy lifestyles across the school.

Total amount for this academic year 2023/2024 £17,670

Ofsted recommendations are that investment should "impact on increasing participation, promoting health and wellbeing and improving performance of all children and groups"

and these are coloured according to the area of impact we are aiming to improve.

This funding comes in line with the sugar tax being introduced and runs hand in hand with the Government's Childhood Obesity Plan (COP). Key points from this plan related to school sports are:

- 1. Today nearly a third of children aged 2 to 15 are overweight or obese.
- 2. Every primary school child should <u>get</u> at least 60 minutes of moderate to vigorous physical activity a day. At least 30 minutes should be <u>delivered</u> in school every day through active break times, PE, extra-curricular clubs, active lessons, or other sport and physical activity events, with the remaining 30 minutes supported by parents and carers outside of school time.
- 3. This will set out how schools can work with the school nurses, health centres, healthy weight teams in local authorities and other resources, to help children develop a healthier lifestyle.
- 4. Sainsbury's School Games Mark contains various points about engaging the inactive population amongst the children and increasing elements engaging SEN children.
