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Safeguarding Notification

We have been made aware of a WhatsApp group called 'everyone you know x' which is going around North Tyneside aimed at year 6 students. There are currently 500 members, and the group encourages members to self-harm.

It has been disclosed that there is a social media trend whereby young people are being encouraged to take overdoses on a points scoring system.

We would like to make parents aware of this concerning notification.

I have spoken to Y5 and Y6 about the name of the group 'everyone you know' but not divulged any detail other than to inform a trusted adult immediately.
